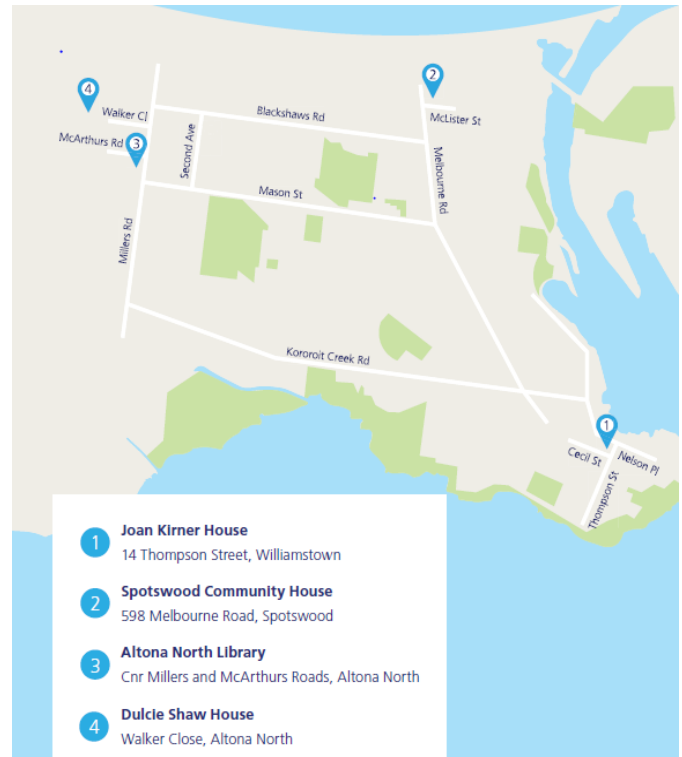

- Williamstown Community and Education Centre is a Registered Training Organisation and offers a wide range of both Pre-accredited and Accredited reading, writing, language and computer classes to the residents of Williamstown and Hobsons Bay.
- A range of programs are offered and are provided at different venues in the local area.
- Accredited training is offered at 14 Thompson St. Units are delivered over 20 weeks and assessed at the end of each semester. All units focus on basic reading, writing and speaking to improve your basic skills.
- Courses are subsidised through the State Government Skills First Program and the Adult Community and Further Education Board, provided individuals meet the Victorian Eligibility requirements.
- If you are unemployed and are registered with Centrelink, you may be eligible for a more intensive class through the Skills for Education and Employment Program (SEE) offered at our Centre.
- The Adult Migrant Education Program (AMEP) is an Australian government-funded program that provides 510 hours of free English classes to new migrants and refugees. All new students need to make an appointment to be interviewed and assessed to ensure they are placed in a suitable class.
