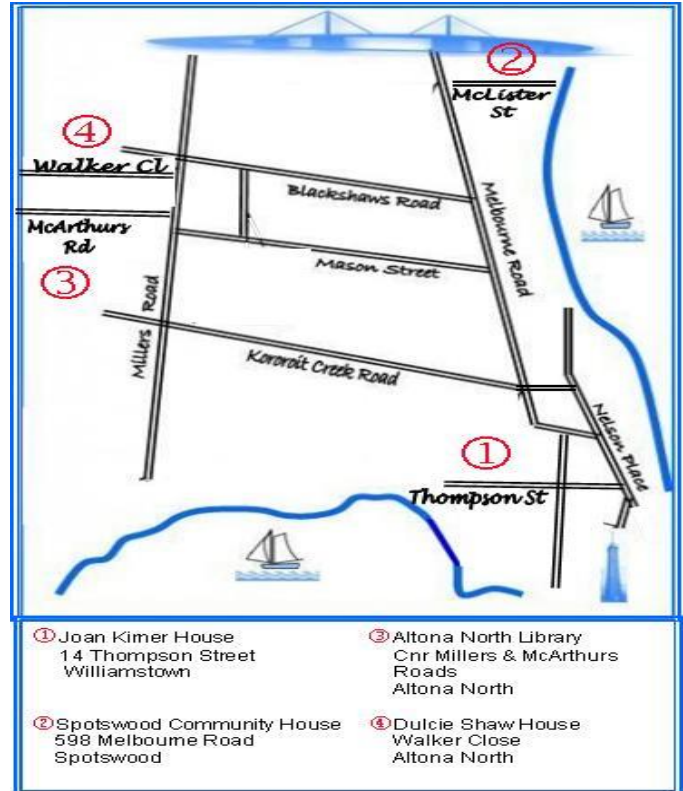

- Williamstown Community and Education Centre is a Registered Training Organisation and offers a wide range of both Pre-accredited and Accredited reading, writing, language and computer classes to the residents of Williamstown and Hobsons Bay.
- A range of programs are offered, and are provided at different venues in the local area.
- Accredited training is offered at 14 Thompson St. Units are delivered over 20 weeks & assessed at the end of each semester. All units focus on basic reading, writing and oracy to improve your basic skills.
- Courses are subsidised through the State Government Skills First Program and the Adult Community and Further Education Board, provided individuals meet the Victorian Eligibility requirements.
- If you are unemployed and are registered with Centrelink you may be eligible for a more intensive class through the Skills for Education and Employment Program (SEE) offered at our Centre.
- The Adult Migrant Education Program (AMEP) is an Australian government-funded program that provides 510 hours of free English classes to new migrants and refugees. Call for more information and to check eligibility.
- All new students need to make an appointment to be interviewed and assessed to ensure they are placed in a suitable class. Accredited courses offered are English as an Additional Language (EAL) Framework and Certificate of General Education for Adults (CGEA).
