





Help has been given to complete citizenship and passport applications, Centrelink forms, resume writing, scholarship applications, utility bill issues, infringement notices, and email and mobile phone support.

We offer face-to-face sessions at Joan Kirner House Williamstown, on Monday and Friday mornings and at Altona North Community House on Thursday mornings.
