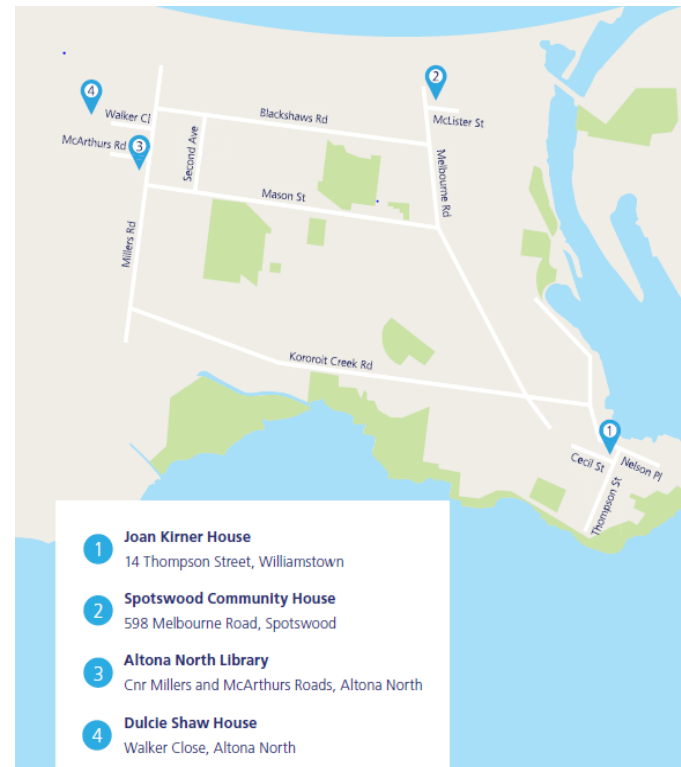

- Courses are subsidised through the State Government Adult Community and Further Education Board, provided individuals meet the Victorian Eligibility requirements.
- The Adult Migrant Education Program (AMEP) is an Australian government-funded program that provides 510 hours of free English classes to new migrants and refugees. All new students need to make an appointment to be interviewed and assessed to ensure they are placed in a suitable class.
