Update - Parking at Joan Kirner House

Our ongoing campaign to have reserved parking for our Centre users on the Thompson **and** Cecil street frontages of Joan Kirner House.

GOOD NEWS - Council recently put signage up to reserve our Thompson Street frontage. So, our campaign is having some impact.

BAD NEWS – Just received news through Facebook (?), that Robina Scott Kindergarten will be running Three-Year-Old programs out of the Council venue at 83 Cecil Street next year.

So, on top of the chaos we already have with St Andrews, Kids by the Bay and ourselves having childcare, on top of this 81 Cecil Street will be redeveloped into a Childcare Centre for Kids by the Bay and 83 Cecil Street will be running all day, every day for Robina Scott!

Drop offs, pick-ups, and general parking will be mayhem.

We need to get our Petition to Council about a month out from their next Council Meeting.


We are aiming for their 13 August Meeting. These meeting are live streamed and recorded. See Council web site <u>HERE</u>.

- A Skills for Education and Employment Provider With six other local providers making up the Learning for Employment Consortium for the Commonwealth Government Department of Education.


Some good news for teachers, we now have two short throw digital projectors, so no more argy bargy on who gets to use which projector B.
